Line-Up Information - *Marshaling instructions and route format will be mailed on or before **October 19**. ** LINE-UP NOTE: Feeder streets Duckworth, Ritter, Elizabeth and Oak will line up facing NORTH and move onto County Road.*

Gaps in the Parade - *Our biggest parade complaint is that there are too many gaps in the parade. **If you are a non-float marching group DO NOT STOP TO PERFORM!** All entries MUST continue to be forward-moving throughout the parade. All entries should be aware of the location of the entry in front of and behind them in order to eliminate such large gaps.*

Floats/Non-Floats will be judged during the parade from the new judge's stand on Walnut Street
